Move-up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in **WRITING** to the TRIAL SECRETARY no later than Monday, June 26th at 6:00 pm (via email or regular mail). Such move-up entries shall be accepted subject to the availability of the class and payment of any difference in the entry fee.

JUMP HEIGHT POLICY

When filling out an entry form, there is a new section on the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please check the box if your dog needs to be measured so that the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to be Measured List. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division and titling class. Dogs may jump in higher height class in regular classes; dogs must jump in proper height class in preferred classes.

JUDGING TIME & COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Judging will begin at 8:00 am on all days (first dog on the line). Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class. The walk through period will be held prior to each class.

Awards & Prizes

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog with a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the top four qualifiers in each height division in each class as follows:

- 1st place Blue Rosette
- 2nd place Red Rosette
- 3rd place Yellow Rosette
- 4th place White Rosette

A qualifying score is required for ALL prizes. "Dog" means either sex. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, MACH, PACH & PAX ribbons, and MACH, PACH & PAX bars will also be awarded. Prizes must be claimed the day of the trial, none will be mailed.

RUN ORDER SHEETS

Run order sheets will be made available on the clubs web site soon after the close of the trial.

Trial Site Rules

Please potty dogs in the designated areas as handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be excused from the trial without a refund.

Please do not park in front of the other businesses in the business park. Please obey the posted signs about where to park.

The Building will open @ 6:45 a.m. each day. No one can enter the building before then.

FOOD:

Food and beverages will be provided for workers. Food for non-workers will not be available for purchase. There are many restaurants within 5 minutes of the show site.

HOTEL INFORMATION:

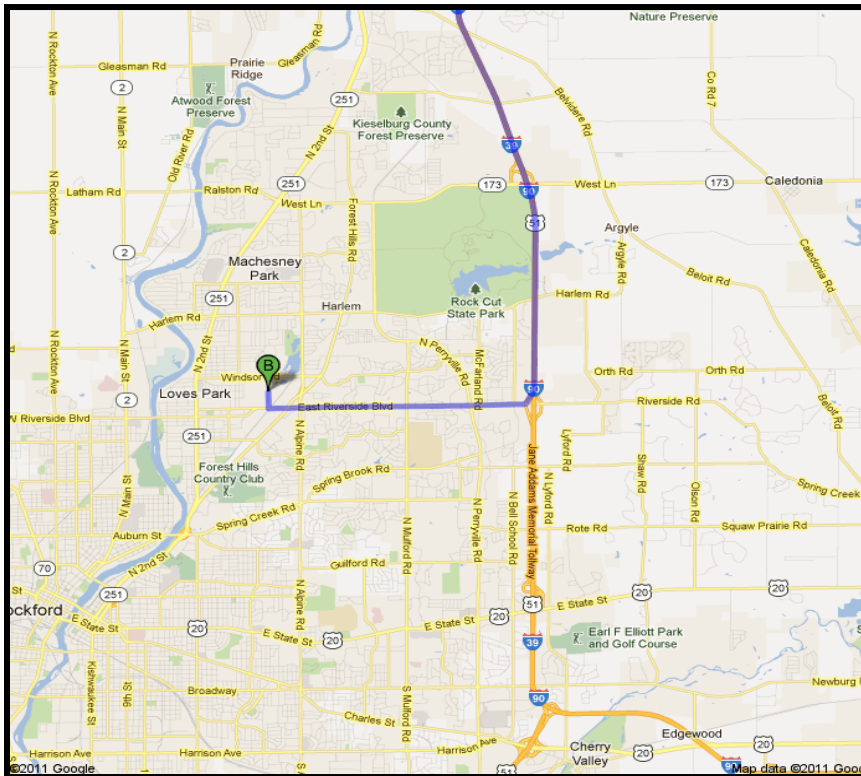

From I90/39: Take the E. Riverside Blvd exit. Turn west onto E. Riverside Blvd towards town. Turn right onto Material Ave. Forest City Dog Training is in the brown industrial park on the right side of the road. Look for the club sign by the road.



Trial Regulations – Notice to Exhibitors

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **not acceptable**.

Fax, telephone, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Mail all entries with fees to: Katrina Hughes, N7699 Cty Road D, Belleville, WI 53508. Overnight mail, UPS and FedEx packages must be sent with “no signature required.” Make all checks & money orders payable to FCDTC. Pay all fees in US dollars. Do not send cash. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. A maximum of ten (10) dogs may be submitted per envelope for entries. **No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.**

If the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, entry fees will not be refunded.

Refunds will not be given for entries withdrawn (other than as stipulated below in the Wait List section) after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are absent or are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Entry fees for bitches that come into season or dogs that are injured after the closing date will be refunded by mail, minus \$15.00 per day fee, if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. Errors on entry form are the owner's responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

WAIT LIST: Entries received after the stated entry limits have been reached (but before the closing date/time) will be held on a wait list to a maximum of 75 entries. If accepted entries are withdrawn before **Monday June 26th at 3pm**, entries on the wait list will be accepted subject to the per-ring limit. Entries withdrawn prior to the 06/26 3pm deadline *that are replaced by a waitlisted entry* will have entry fees reimbursed in full, as will any unaccepted wait list entries.

Declinations of entries: Forest City Dog Training Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall not have any claim or recourse against Forest City Dog Training Club.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having its dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged. **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging. **Dogs not required** for further judging will be excused.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration, a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs) or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) number. Not eligible are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Dogs and children at the trial site must be in the control of their handler or parent. Any exhibitor whose dog or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the trial committee be asked to leave the trial site. Puppies under six months of age are prohibited from the trial site. Pinch collars, citronella collars, electric and dummy electric collars, gentle leaders, and similar halter collars are prohibited on the trial site.

The safety of the dogs is the primary concern of Forest City Dog Training Club. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. **Forest City Dog Training Club** is not responsible for the loss of, injury to or the death of any dog exhibited or the loss of or damage to any participant whether the result of an accident or other cause.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
