**INCLEMENT WEATHER:** In the event of extreme weather conditions the Club may take such action as necessary to protect the health and safety of the dogs, handlers and judges, including postponement or cancellation of the test.

#### **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS**

**All dogs must be on leash at all times during the hours of this test. Please be respectful of this property and clean up after your dogs.**

**Entry Limits: TD** - There are eight tracks as set by the AKC tracking regulations.  
**Bitches in Season** will be allowed to participate subject to the conditions set forth in Chapter 2, Section 8 of the Tracking Regulations

**Drawing:** The procedures specified in Chapter 1, Section 11 of the Tracking Regulations shall be observed. A drawing of the entries and assignments of position on the alternate list will be held at 4232 Valley View Dr., Loves Park, IL at 5:00 P.M. on the closing date of this test. The Test Secretary will attempt to contact all entrants of the draw results within 48 hours of the drawing and send the Judging Program by email no less than seven (7) days prior to the test. You may email the Test Secretary after the draw.

**Certification for TD test:** A written statement must accompany each entry form for a dog which has not passed an AKC TD or TDU test. This statement must be dated within two years of the date of this test and be signed by either a person approved to judge tracking tests or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST within the last ten years. This statement must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. The holding of other titles including TD, VST or TDX shall not bar a dog from competition in this test. Dogs without any tracking title will be accepted first.

**An alternate list** will be maintained. Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate list. Also, entry fees will be refunded to alternates who do not participate in the Test. Entry fees will NOT be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the Test unless an alternate is present and runs in place of the absent dog.

**Risk:** The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Forest City Dog Training Club assumes no responsibility for any personal property, theft,

injury or death of any animal or loss of, or damage to any property while at this test or the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

**Disaster and Emergency Preparedness Plan:** The Forest City Dog Training Club has prepared such a plan for this event and it is available to all participants upon request, and will be available at the test site

**Meals:** Per AKC Covid-19 best practices, food and drink will **NOT** be available. Participants should bring their own snacks/lunch/drinks.

**Directions to the site:** From I-90 Westbound: Take Hwy 47 exit and go South on 47. Travel 3.4 miles to Hwy 72 and turn right. Travel 6 miles and turn left onto Walker Rd. Travel 1.5 miles and turn right onto Lenschow Rd. Travel ½ mile and turn left onto Engel Rd. Proceed South, the preserve entrance is on the right. From I-90 Eastbound: Take the Genoa Rd. (County Road 4) exit and go South on Genoa Rd. Travel 11.5 miles to Genoa, where the road becomes Hwy 72. Continue East on Hwy 72 another 5 miles to Engel Road and turn right. The road dead-ends at Lenschow Rd. Turn left and then immediately turn right onto Engel Rd. The preserve entrance is on the right.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION, HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Coonies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)
