Do **NOT** send entries by any method requiring a signature for delivery.

ALL CANCELLATIONS of entries must be made in writing to the Test Secretary & received prior to the stated date & time of closing of entries.

CLOSING DATE: Monday, May 2, 2022 at 5 PM local time at the home of the test secretary.

DRAW FOR ENTRIES: held at 7:00 PM local time on Monday, May 2, 2022 at the home of the test secretary, 4232 Valley View Dr., Loves Park, IL 61111

DRAWING FOR TRACKS: Sunday, May 15, 2022 at 9:00 AM local time at 15787 Crowley Rd., Durand, IL
First Track will be run immediately after, conditions permitting.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In the event of extreme weather conditions the Club may take such action as necessary to protect the health and safety of the dogs, handlers and judges, including postponement or cancellation of the test.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

All dogs must be on leash at all times during the hours of this test. The test property and the surrounding areas are private property. Please be respectful of this property and clean up after your dogs.

Entry Limits: TD - There are eight tracks offered with two tracks being set aside for test workers as set by the AKC tracking regulations.

Bitches in Season will be allowed to participate subject to the conditions set forth in Chapter 2, Section 8 of the Tracking Regulations

Test Worker Options: Two tracks will be reserved for test workers who have worked two days for Forest City Dog Training Club or another tracking club and have a certificate attesting to this. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test workers are chosen. The remaining workers will automatically be included in the drawing with all other tracking entries received. This Worker Certificate must accompany the entry in order to be considered.

Drawing: The procedures specified in Chapter 1, Section 11 of the Tracking Regulations shall be observed. A drawing of the entries and assignments of position on the alternate list will be held at 4232 Valley View Dr., Loves Park, IL at 7:00 P.M. on the closing date of this test. The Test Secretary will attempt to contact all entrants of the draw results within 48 hours of the drawing and send the Judging Program by email no less than seven (7) days prior to the test. You may email the Test Secretary after the draw.

Certification for TD test: A written statement must accompany each entry form for a dog which has not passed an AKC TD or TDU test. This statement must be dated within two years of the date of this test and be signed by either a person approved to judge tracking tests or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST within the last ten (10) years. This statement must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. The holding of other titles including

TD, VST or TDX shall not bar a dog from competition in this test. Dogs without any tracking title will be accepted first.

An alternate list will be maintained. Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate list. Also, entry fees will be refunded to alternates who do not participate in the Test. Entry fees will NOT be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the Test unless an alternate is present and runs in place of the absent dog.

Risk: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Forest City Dog Training Club assumes no responsibility for any personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal or loss

of, or damage to any property while at this test or the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

Disaster and Emergency Preparedness Plan: The Forest City Dog Training Club has prepared such a plan for this event and it is available to all participants upon request, and will be available at the test site

Meals: Per AKC Covid-19 best practices, food and drink will **NOT** be available. Participants should bring their own snacks/lunch/drinks.

Directions to the site: The address of the site is 15787 Crowley Rd., Durand, IL Durand is NE of Freeport, IL & NW of Rockford, IL. From Rockford, IL, follow IL-70 to Moate Rd. In Harrison Township, turn left onto W. Jefferson St., turn right onto IL-70 W/Kilburn Ave., turn right onto Moate Rd., turn left onto IL-75 W. Continue on Wheeler Rd., turn left onto Yale Bridge Rd., turn right on Crowley Rd. This is a private property. No access without permission.
