Move-up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title at a previous trial, provided that the request is made in **WRITING** to the TRIAL SECRETARY no later than Monday, November 23rd at 6:00 pm (via email or regular mail). Such move-up entries shall be accepted subject to the availability of the class and payment of any difference in the entry fee.

AKC AGILITY CLASS MOVE UP FORM

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made **in writing** to the trial secretary only. Move ups for November 27th must be received no later than 6:00 pm Monday, November 23rd. Move ups for November 28th & 29th will be accepted the day prior until the last ribbons are awarded.

Please do not sign-up to work the small class heights if you are running tall dogs and vice versa. You are not allowed to stay in the building after you are done running even to work.

JUDGING TIME & COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Judging will begin at 8:00 am on all days (first dog on the line). Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class.

Awards & Prizes

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog with a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the top four qualifiers in each height division in each class as follows:

1 st place	Blue Rosette
2 nd place	Red Rosette
3 rd place	Yellow Rosette
4 th place	White Rosette

A qualifying score is required for ALL prizes. "Dog" means either sex. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, MACH or PACH ribbons plus a MACH or PACH bars will also be awarded. A PAX ribbon & bar will be given for only the first PAX title. Prizes must be claimed the day of the trial as none will be mailed.

COVID-19: All events will be conducted in accordance with AKC recommendations as well as state and local regulations in place at the time of the event.

JUMP HEIGHT POLICY

When filling out an entry form, please check the box if your dog needs to be measured so that the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to be Measured List. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Run order sheets will be made available on the club's web site soon after the close of the trial.

Trial Site Rules

Please potty dogs in the designated areas as handlers who do not clean up after their dogs will be excused from the trial without a refund.

Please do not park in front of the other businesses in the business park. Please obey the posted signs about where to park. RV parking is allowed by permit only. Please email Cheerie Ohda @ moonic1130@aol.com to ask permission and for directions on where to park.

The Building will open @ 6:45 a.m. each day. No one can enter the building before then. Note: The Ex/MAS classes will be split by height in the run order. Only EX/Mas tall dogs will be allowed in the building in the morning then they will clear the building so that the EX/Mas small dogs can set-up then run. Please do not plan on coming early or staying after your all your runs have been completed. Open/Novice dogs will not be allowed in the building until after the Ex/Mas runs have been completed and the exhibitors have cleared the building.

Trial Regulations – Notice to Exhibitors

FOOD:

Food and beverages will not be provided for no one. There are many restaurants within 5 minutes of the show site.

HOTEL INFORMATION:

The following area hotels accept well-behaved people and their pets. Exhibitors must contact hotels directly and identify themselves as having dogs. 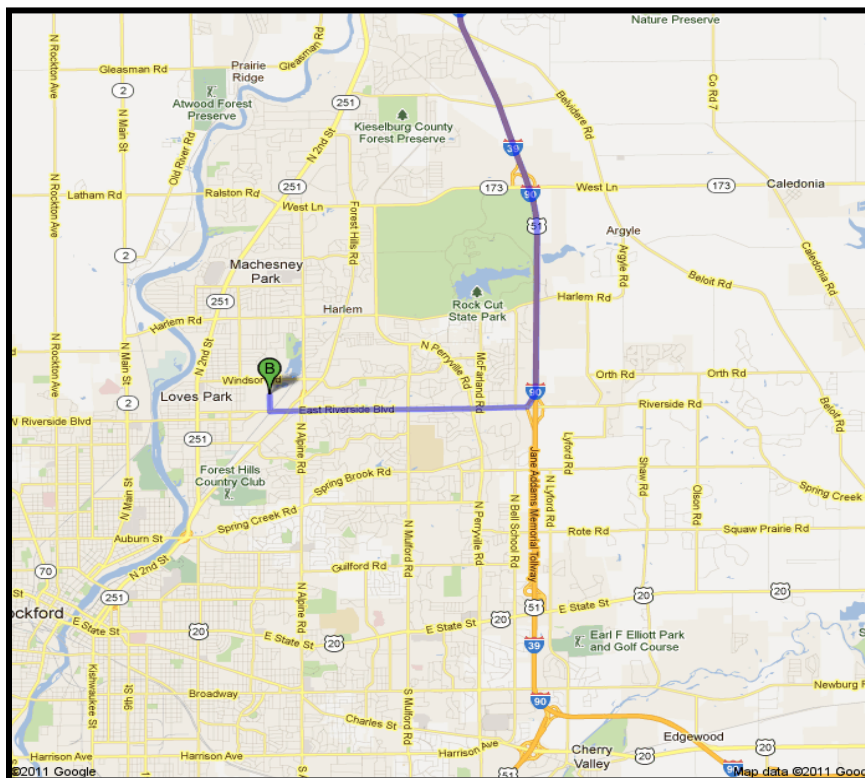

Directions to the Show Location

From I90/39: Take the E. Riverside Blvd exit. Turn west onto E. Riverside Blvd towards town. Turn right onto Material Ave. Forest City Dog Training is in the brown industrial park on the right side of the road. Look for the club sign by the road.



Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **not acceptable**.

Fax, telephone, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Mail all entries with fees to: Katrina Hughes, N7699 Cty Road D, Belleville, WI 53508. Overnight mail, UPS and FedEx packages must be sent with “no signature required.” Make all checks & money orders payable to FCDTC. Pay all fees in US dollars. Do not send cash. Entries received without fees or incorrect fees will not be accepted. Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. A maximum of ten (10) dogs may be submitted per envelope for entries. **No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.**

If the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, entry fees will not be refunded.

Refunds will not be given for entries withdrawn (other than as stipulated below in the Wait List section) after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are absent or are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Entry fees for bitches that come into season or dogs that are injured after the closing date will be refunded by mail, minus \$15.00 per day fee, if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. Errors on entry form are the owner's responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

WAIT LIST: Entries received after the stated entry limits have been reached (but before the closing date/time) will be held on a wait list to a maximum of 75 entries. If accepted entries are withdrawn before **Monday Nov 23rd at 3pm**, entries on the wait list will be accepted subject to the per-ring limit. Entries withdrawn prior to the 11/23 3 pm deadline **that are replaced by a waitlisted entry** will have entry fees reimbursed in full, as will any unaccepted wait list entries.

Declinations of entries: Forest City Dog Training Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall not have any claim or recourse against Forest City Dog Training Club.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having its dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged. **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging. **Dogs not required** for further judging will be excused.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration, a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs) or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) number. Not eligible are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Dogs and children at the trial site must be in the control of their handler or parent. Any exhibitor whose dog or child engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the trial committee be asked to leave the trial site. Puppies under six months of age are prohibited from the trial site. Pinch collars, citronella collars, electric and dummy electric collars, gentle leaders, and similar halter collars are prohibited on the trial site.

The safety of the dogs is the primary concern of Forest City Dog Training Club. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. **Forest City Dog Training Club** is not responsible for the loss of, injury to or the death of any dog exhibited or the loss of or damage to any participant whether the result of an accident or other cause.

ENTRY FEES: \$22.00 for 1st run, \$18.00 2nd & 3rd run same dog the same day (includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee for 1st entry and \$3.00 AKC recording fee after the 1st run for each day)
