JUMP HEIGHT POLICY

When filling out an entry form, please check the box if your dog needs to be measured so that the trial secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to be Measured List. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

E-mail confirmations will be sent when your entry is received and accepted. If you do not have an e-mail address, please include a self-addressed stamped postcard to receive confirmation that you made entry into the trial.

Move-up Information

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, because of qualifying for an agility title at a previous trial, provided that the request is made in **WRITING** to the TRIAL SECRETARY no later than December 26th at 6:00 pm (via email or regular mail). Such move-up entries shall be accepted subject to the availability of the class and payment of any difference in the entry fee.

AKC AGILITY CLASS MOVE UP FORM

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, because of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made **in writing** to the trial secretary only. Move ups for December 29th must be received no later than 6:00 pm December 26th. Move ups for December 30th will be accepted the day prior until the last ribbons are awarded.

JUDGING TIME & COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Judging will begin at 8:00 am on all days (first dog on the line). Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered only in that class.

Awards & Prizes

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be given to each dog with a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the top four qualifiers in each height division in each class as follows:

- 1st place Blue Rosette
- 2nd place Red Rosette
- 3rd place Yellow Rosette
- 4th place White Rosette

A qualifying score is required for ALL prizes. "Dog" means either sex. New title ribbons, Double Q ribbons, MACH or PACH ribbons plus a MACH or PACH bar will also be awarded. Prizes must be claimed the day of the trial as none will be mailed.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

FOOD:

Food and beverages will not be provided for anyone. There are many restaurants within 5 minutes of the show site.

HOTEL INFORMATION:

The following area hotels accept well-behaved people and their pets. Exhibitors must contact hotels directly and identify themselves as having dogs. Some of these hotels do charge an extra fee for dogs. Be sure to verify the dog policy with the hotel of your choice when you make your reservation. Please be a responsible owner and a considerate hotel guest by maintaining a restful atmosphere and cleaning up after your dog.

Directions to the Show Location

From I90/39: Take the E. Riverside Blvd exit. Turn west onto E. Riverside Blvd towards town. Turn right onto Material Ave. Forest City Dog Training is in the brown industrial park on the right side of the road.

Trial Regulations – Notice to Exhibitors

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **not acceptable**.

Fax, telephone, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Mail all entries with fees to: Katrina Hughes, N7699 County Road D, Belleville, WI 53508. Overnight mail, UPS and FedEx packages must be sent with "no signature required." Make all checks & money orders payable to FCDTC. Pay all fees in US dollars. Do not send cash. Entries received without fees or incorrect fees will not be accepted. Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. A maximum of ten (10) dogs may be submitted per envelope for entries.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

If the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee, entry fees will not be refunded.

Refunds will not be given for entries withdrawn (other than as stipulated below in the Wait List section) after the closing date or in the event a dog and /or handler are absent or are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Entry fees for bitches that come into season or dogs that are injured after the closing date will be refunded by mail, minus \$15.00 per day fee, if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. Errors on entry form are the owner's responsibility and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the trial has closed.

WAIT LIST: Entries received after the stated entry limits have been reached (but before the closing date/time) will be held on a wait list to a maximum of 75 entries. If accepted entries are withdrawn before **December 26th at 3pm**, entries on the wait list will be accepted subject to the per ring limit. Entries withdrawn prior to the 12/26 3 pm deadline **that are replaced by a waitlisted entry** will have entry fees reimbursed in full, as will any unaccepted wait list entries.

Declinations of entries: Forest City Dog Training Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove dogs on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes and no one shall not have any claim or recourse against Forest City Dog Training Club.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having its dog ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration, a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs) or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) number. Not eligible are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

The safety of the dogs is the primary concern of Forest City Dog Training Club. By entering this trial exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. **Forest City Dog Training Club** is not responsible for the loss of, injury to or the death of any dog exhibited or the loss of or damage to any participant whether the result of an accident or other cause.

COVID-19: We will be following the most up to date information regarding COVID-19 protocols and precautions that is available at the time of the trial. All events will be conducted in accordance with AKC recommendations as well as state and local regulations in place at the time of the event.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
