ENTRY FEE: TD-\$85 TDX-\$185 (Includes AKC Recording fee & Event Services Fee). Make checks payable in US Funds to Forest City Dog Training Club (FCDTTC) and mail to : Sarah Kittner,15787 Crowley Road, Durand, IL 61024-9528.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$30 fee will be charged for any returned check. Fees must accompany all entries. Entries must be made on an official AKC entry form. Do not send entries by any method requiring a signature for delivery. All cancellations of entries must be made in writing to the Test Secretary & received prior to the stated date & time of closing of entries.

CLOSING DATE: Thursday, April 30, 2026 at 5:00 PM local time at the home of the test secretary.

DRAW FOR ENTRIES: will be held at 7:00 PM local time on Thursday, April 30, 2026 at the home of the Test Secretary, 15787 Crowley Road, Durand, IL 61024-9528. The procedures specified in Chapter 1, Section 11 of the Tracking Regulations shall be observed. A drawing of the entries and assignments of position on the alternate list will be done. The Test Secretary will attempt to contact all entrants of the draw with the results within 48 hours of the drawing and send the Judging Program by e-mail no less than seven days prior to the test. You may e-mail the Secretary after the draw. The drawing shall be completely random. However, preference for entry in the TD will be for dogs that have not received an AKC TD or TDU title and in the TDX for dogs that have not yet earned an AKC TDX title. This test is open to all AKC-registered dogs, including Canine Partners as well as to the Test Secretary.

ENTRY LIMITS: Entries are limited to six tracks for the TD and two tracks for the TDX.

TEST WORKER OPTION: At the Draw for Participants, 2 Tracks will be set aside as per Chapter 1, Sec. 17d. Please put "Test Worker" at the top of your entry and include your Worker Certificate.

CERTIFICATION FOR TD TEST: A written statement must accompany each entry for a dog which has not passed an AKC TD or TDU test. This statement must be dated within two years of the date of this test and be signed by either a person approved to judge tracking tests or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST with the last ten years. This statement must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. The holding of other titles including TD, VST, or TDX shall not bar a dog from the competition. Dogs without any tracking title will be accepted first.

Alternate List: An alternate list will be maintained. Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate list. Also, entry fees will be refunded to alternates who do not participate in the Test. Entry fees will NOT be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the test unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS: All dogs must be on leash at all times during the hours of this test. The test property and surrounding areas are private property. Please be respectful of this property and clean up after your dog.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In the event of extreme weather conditions, the Club may take such action as necessary to protect the health and safety of the dogs, handlers and judges; including postponement or cancellation of the test.

RISKS: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Forest City Dog Training Club assumes no responsibility for any personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal or loss of, or damage to any property while at this test or test site, or in transit to or from the site.

DISASTER AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN: The Forest City Dog Training Club has prepared such a plan for this event and it is available to all participants upon request and it will be available at the test site.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: The address of the site is 15787 Crowley Road, Durand, IL. The city of Durand is NE of Freeport, IL and NW of Rockford, IL.

From the East: From I-90, take exit 3 for E. Rockton Rd, keeping left at the fork, follow signs to Rockton/Roscoe. Merge onto E Rockton Rd. In 2.3 miles, turn right onto Dorr Road. In one mile, turn left onto Prairie Hill Rd. Then in 1.6 miles, turn left onto S. Bluff Rd. and in .2 miles turn right onto Yale Bridge Rd. Stay on Yale Bridge for 13 miles and then turn right on to Crowley. 15787 will be on the right in .9 miles.

From the North: If coming by I-90, take exit 1 for IL-75W/US-51 N towards S Beloit. In .3miles turn right onto IL-75W/US51N for 1.2 miles then continue straight onto Gardner Street for .9 miles. You will then turn left onto Blackhawk Blvd. In 1.9 miles, turn right onto Prairie Hill Road. Turn left in .6 miles onto S Bluff Rd and in .2 miles turn right on Yale Bridge Rd. Stay on Yale Bridge for 13 miles and then turn right on to Crowley Rd for .9 miles. 15787 will be on the right.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
